WIMNI provides enriching social and educational programs for children, families, and adults to create connection and belonging in our diverse community.



RCHP Affordable Housing Corporation

RCHP-AHC purchases, rehabs, and opens doors for low-income persons, and helps create support systems for over 1,500 NJ residents.



Interfaith-RISE

Interfaith-RISE provides services to about 2,000 refugees each year, including housing, language learning, employment, case management, school impact, cash assistance, health, intensive case management, and more.



Global Grace Health Be the Change, NJ

GGH-Be the Change NJ is a mobile COVID vaccine and testing program, focusing on serving low-income and underserved populations.



Accompany Now!

Accompany Now! provides home studies and post-release services to about 1,000 children per year who have crossed the US border without parent or guardian, or who have become separated from that parent or guardian.



RCHP-AHC Re-Entry Housing

RCHP-AHC Re-Entry provides assistance to people returning home from NJ state prisons in finding permanent housing for themselves and their families.



Churches Improving Communities

CIC oversees many programs, which assist undocumented immigrants, re-entering citizens, persons with cancer, and church-based mental health services



Still Waters Anti-Trafficking Program

Still Waters assists people who have been subjected to human trafficking, whether to labor trafficking or sex trafficking.
Survivors receive multiple forms of assistance, and the program serves about 60 people per year.
